At a regular second meeting of the Board of Education at Old Village School, 405 W. Main, Northville, Michigan, the Board took the following action:

- The Board accepted the consent agenda items for approval as presented: Minutes of the 06/13/06 Regular Meeting of the Board of Education; and Minutes of the 06/21/06 Special Call Meeting of the Board of Education;
- President Paciorek presented Certificates of Appreciation to the 2006 Girls' Varsity Soccer Champs.
- President Paciorek presented Certificates of Appreciation to the Boys' Varsity baseball Champs.
- President Paciorek presented Certificates of Appreciation to the 2006 Boys' Track – All State Champs.
- The Board hired Mr. Rob Watson as Principal of Northville High School effective July 1, 2006.
- State Representative John Stewart provided a legislative update regarding 20(J) money and School Aid Fund.
- Hillside Teacher Dee Krause received a Certificate of Appreciation from the Board for being selected Teacher of the Year from the National Council for Social Studies.
- Several citizens from the Thornton Creek area inquired about third grade class sizes at Thornton Creek and why the district reduced that grade level to three classrooms. They asked where there was a contingency plan, loss of a third grade teacher at Thornton Creek, cutting of language classes, and the importance of class size being a top priority. Extensive discussion ensued and the Board reassured all parties that Assistant Superintendent Dave Bolitho will be gathering enrollment data throughout the summer. When the principals return mid-August, the district will have an accurate picture to determine whether classrooms additions will be required or whether Aides will be needed. The Board invited citizens to attend the August 15, 2006 Finance Subcommittee meeting (7:00 p.m., Room COA 302) to see how the Board and Administration arrive at determining class size and additional classrooms and/or teachers.
- The Board adopted the 2006/07 budget.
- The Board approved Policy #5119 – Students Leaving or Entering the School District and Policy #5142 – Wellness Program.
- The Board moved into Executive Session for purposes of discussing legal counsel. The Board next approved the continued employment of Mr. Richard Tabor as teacher at Amerman Elementary.
