At a regular meeting of the Board of Education at Old Village School, Northville, Michigan, the Board took the following action:

- The Board received two communications: February 2007 Reports from Northville Youth Assistance and Northville Parks and Recreation. Mr. Roth also informed citizens that there is a change in the structure of Parks & Recreation Commission. Group will be replaced by a commission of elected officials: 3 from Township; 2 from City and 1 from Northville Board of Education.
- The Board approved the following consent agenda items: a) Minutes of the 02/27/07 Regular Second Meeting of the Board of Education; b) Approval of Policy 6164 – Section 504 The Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Educational Services; and c) Bill Warrants and Payroll totaling \$2,401,670.91.
- The Council for Exceptional Children, as well as the Board of Education, recognized Ms. Laura McMillan, Para Educator/Cooke School upon receiving the “Exceptional Parent Award” and Ms. Alyssa Duncan, Student, Northville High School who received the “2007 Yes, I Can Award.”
- The Board of Education presented a Certificate of Recognition to the Redford Suburban League who donated \$17,000 to the Center Program at Old Village School to assist with their leisure recreation, community based programs and student equipment. Mr. Art Fischer presented them a unique tile plaque (with students’ handprints on it) to the Redford Suburban League for their generous donation.
- Dr. Rezmierski announced the passing of Mr. John Schlosser, President of the American Federation of Paraprofessionals. He also attended the viewing of a Ridge Wood parent who passed away Monday.
- The Board approved the proposed attendance boundary criteria for the 2007/08 school year. Please see district website and/or ListServ for the criteria and proposed boundary changes. Two public forums will be held on March 16, 2007 – 9:15-10:00 and 10:15-11:00 a.m. at Ridge Wood Elementary (cafeteria) and Monday, March 19th – 6:00-6:45 p.m. and 7:00-7:45 p.m. at Thornton Creek Elementary (Cafeteria).
