At a regular meeting of the Board of Education at Old Village School, 405 W. Main, Northville, Michigan, the Board took the following action:

- The Board approved the following consent agenda items: Minutes of the 08/28/07 Regular Second Meeting of the Board of Education; New teacher hires: Lynda Davies, Tricia Jendretzke, Shannon Torres, and Sophia Vrtachnik; Bill Warrants and Payroll totaling \$1,904,999.61.
- The Board added one agenda item, 12a) – Direct Purchase of Natural Gas.
- Former Representative John Stewart spoke about the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Sputnik.
