At a regular meeting of the Board of Education at Old Village School, 405 W. Main, Northville, Michigan, the Board took the following action:

- The Board approved the following consent agenda items: Minutes of the 09/24/07 Regular Second Meeting of the Board of Education; Donations from multiple families totaling \$685 in memory of Abigail Tolles to Old Village School to help fund Music Therapy Program; Approval of the following policy for second reading: 1180 – Board Operations – Conflict of Interest; New certified teacher hires: Amanda Good and Ann Maguire; Approval of a resolution requesting funding under State Aid, Section 20 (8); and Bill Warrants and Payroll totaling \$2,121,337.79.
- Superintendent Rezmierski informed the Board that he attended the MASSP Conference in Traverse City on Monday, October 1st where Jim Cracraft was selected Middle Level Principal of the Year. Mr. Cracraft and his family were present when he accepted this award.
- Superintendent Rezmierski stated that all 2007 Homecoming activities were successful and congratulated the high school administrative team for a job well done!
- Superintendent mentioned the opening, in the near future, of a Wayne County satellite office in Northville to better serve the citizens.
- Mr. Rick Rojas gave a presentation on his ESL Program including the new “NPS English as a Second Language/Title III Program 2007/08” to help keep the ESL Program consistent throughout the district.
- The Board approved the expenditure of funds to complete the Office of Civil Rights Resolution Projects.
- The Board approved the resolution to join the Michigan Purchasing Card Consortium, Inc. and the resolution to authorize the use of cards as issued by JPMorgan Chase Bank.
- The Board moved to enter into Executive Session for purposes of negotiations.
