At a regular meeting of the Board of Education at Old Village School, 405 W. Main, Northville, Michigan, the Board took the following action:

- The Board received the Northville Youth Assistance Program Report – November 2007 and Northville Parks & Recreation – September/October 2007 Report.
- The Board approved the following consent agenda items: Minutes of the 10/23/07 Regular Second Meeting of the Board of Education; Donation of \$1,500 from Mrs. Christy Rook and St. Mary’s Cement Company to Hillside Middle School to support student activities and support materials for special education students; and Bill Warrants & Payroll totaling \$2,291,210.24.
- Superintendent Rezmierski and the Board of Education gave recognition to Dr. Steve Anderson for being named MEMPSA 2008 Elementary Principal of the Year.
- Superintendent Rezmierski mentioned that the student from Amerman involved in a car accident is recovering.
- The Board approved administration’s recommended Facility Fee Rates pending Recreation Department developing special user fee rates for Northville Public Schools.
- The Board approved a five (5) year contract with Coca Cola, pending contract review by the district’s legal counsel.
- The Board approved the property transfer between South Lyon Community Schools and Northville Public Schools in the Kirkway Estates Subdivision.
- The Board approved the costs associated with the School Safety Legislation on Fingerprinting (approximately \$49,000) of staff using Live Scan.
- The Board moved into Executive Session for purposes of negotiations.
