At a Regular Second Meeting of the Board of Education at Hillside Middle School, 775 N. Center Street, Northville, Michigan, the Board took the following action:

- The Board approved the following consent agenda items: a) Minutes of the 10/14/08 Regular Meeting of the Board of Education; b) New certified teacher hires: ; c) Out of State Field Trip Requests: Washington, DC – May 2009 – Hillside Middle School and France & Switzerland – July 2010 – Northville High School; and d) Partial Day/Full-Day Kindergarten Study Charge.

- Superintendent Rezmierski commented on the recent media news about a neighboring school district granting a FOIA request for the release of ListServ email list. Dr. Rezmierski said the district has never released any information about students, staff or parents. He will be attending a superintendents meeting next week where further discussions might ensue. He will keep the citizens informed.
