At a Regular Meeting of the Board of Education at Old Village School, 405 W. Main, Northville, Michigan, the Board took the following action:

- One added agenda item: 11a) Annual Summer Tax Collection Resolution.
- The Board received two communications: Wayne RESA Board Highlights – 11/18/09 and Northville Youth Assistance Program Report for December, 2009.
- The Board approved the following consent agenda items: a) Minutes of the 11/17/09 Regular Second Meeting of the Board of Education; b) Minutes of the 11/24/09 Special Call Meeting of the Board of Education; and c) Bill warrants totaling \$1,933,061.14.
- The Board recognized Ms. Judy Handley, Board Secretary, who is retiring effective 12/31/09, after serving 12 ½ years of service.
- The Board presented a check for \$2,495 from the Northville Public Schools' staff to Northville Civic Concern.
- Winchester Principal Pat Messing thanked Mrs. Handley for her dedication and commitment to the children in the Northville Public School District. She introduced her staff and Winchester PTA President Maureen Ziparo and Secretary Jen Garliauskas. Ms. Messing showed a PowerPoint presentation on Winchester's School Improvement Goals and Rationale for 2009/10. Goal 1 – Improve Student Performance in Writing; Goal 2 – Increase Basic Math Fact Fluency for All Students grades 1-5; Long-Range Initiative 1 – Building a Sense of Community; Long-Range Initiative 2 – Provide Opportunities at Home for Parents to be involved in their Child's Learning; and Long-Range Initiative 3 – Increase our Capacity as Interventionists in Reading. She also explained the rationale and assessment of each of the Goals and initiatives.
- The Board approved Policy 5111 – Student Enrollment/Age of Entrance for first reading.
- The Board approved the Annual Summer Tax Resolution.
