BOARD POLICY

CITIZEN COMMENT AT SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

This policy provides for the orderly conduct of regular school Board Meetings, and provides adequate and reasonable opportunity for citizens to offer their views and opinions regarding the school district.

The Board will allow at least two opportunities for citizen comment at School Board meetings.

Citizens wishing to address the Board are requested to file a completed visitor's comment form with the Secretary of the Board. The Board President will then call on the citizens who have made a request to speak.

Citizens will be given a maximum of 3 minutes to address any agenda item or to express their views during either citizen comment period. The presiding officer will insure that this policy is followed.
