



Co-Curricular/ Extra Curricular

Student Activities are divided into two categories, co curricular and extra curricular activities. Although student activities are intended to have at least an indirect relationship to some segment of the school's curriculum, the distinction between the two types of activities is that co curricular activities require attendance at after school events as a requirement of the course and student performance is graded. An example of a co curricular activity would be vocal and instrumental music students who are required to attend performances and festivals and are graded for their level of achievement. The Northville Public Schools allocates funds to compensate sponsors of some of the groups (\$85,000 annually), while other groups are led by volunteer sponsors. The middle school bands receive an annual allocation of \$3,100 each to purchase music and to repair instruments. The high school instrumental and vocal programs receive a total of \$19,800 for the same expenses.
