

Middle School Advanced Math Opportunity Grade 7 Consideration for Grade 8 Placement

Parent Direction Form

Seventh grade students who have achieved A's (A+, A or A-) on all their seventh grade math report cards have an opportunity to qualify for eighth grade Honors Algebra 1. Parents who have evidence that their student would better be served in an advanced math level course need to submit the *Middle School Advanced Math Opportunity* form and attach any outside testing if applicable.

The *Middle School Advanced Math Opportunity* form can be obtained either at the school office or the district web site www.northville.k12.mi.us. The form needs to be submitted by the **second Friday in March** to the student's counselor. Students can elect to take all the tests, just those provided by the school system, or any combination. Teachers will document those tests administered during the school day. Parents need to document and attach any of the following tests they elect to have their student take: ACT, SAT or any private outside national achievement and ability math scores. Seventh grade **students who have achieved all A's on their math report card, must pass three of the qualifying scores in order to be considered for advanced math**. If students need only one more score, they can sign up for the Cumulative Advanced Math Placement Test (CAMPT).

Scores must be submitted to the Office of Instruction by mid-April (with the exception of the CAMPT) for consideration. Parents will receive a letter from the Office of Instruction by mid-May updating them on the status of the request and whether their student qualifies to take the CAMPT.

After the CAMPT scores have been submitted and a committee has reviewed all the information, parents will be notified of the final determination during the summer months.

The scores must be from the same school year. For those tests* administered out of the district, proof of scores must be attached. Additional information about each of these tests is provided by math teachers, counselors, building offices, district/test website, and school newsletters throughout the year. Parents could also provide a copy of any awards, achievements, classes associated with math and given beyond the school day if those documents should be considered.
