For 2010-2011, Northville High School made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve.

School Improvement Goals for 2011-12

1. All Northville High School students will be proficient in mathematics.
2. All Northville High School students will be proficient in English Language Arts.
3. All Northville High School students will participate in a school-wide behavioral and instructional management system to maximize academic and social success as well as attendance, and minimize office discipline referrals.

The school's curriculum is aligned with the Michigan Department of Education High School Content Standards and Michigan Merit Curriculum. Each content area committee analyzes the curriculum to ensure that it is aligned with state grade level expectations.
