Dear Parents and Community Members:

Cooke School is pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2010-2011 educational progress for our school. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. Cooke School is a special education center program that services students from twelve local school districts in Western Wayne County. Our population includes students ages 14 through 26 years old, who are severely cognitively impaired, severely multiply impaired, and students dual-diagnosed with a cognitive and emotional impairment. The special education center program is funded by the Wayne County Regional Educational Service Agency and operated by Northville Public Schools.

For 2010-2011, Cooke School was established as a Shared Educational Entity with the twelve local school districts whose students we serve. Due to Cooke School's status as a Shared Educational Entity, our students' assessment scores were sent back to their resident districts, and therefore did not receive an Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) status under the federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act for the 2010-2011 school year.

Cooke School is diligently working on our building school improvement plan with specific goals in the areas of reading; including word study and reading comprehension, mathematics, and positive behavior support. We are entering into our first year with goals in the area of mathematics, and hope to show significant achievement over the next three years. We are continually increasing our expectations in the area of positive behavior for our students, and are close to achieving this goal. The school's curriculum is aligned with the Michigan Department of Education Extended Grade Level Content Standards that was created in 2007 for students with Cognitive Impairments. Cooke is currently in the process of aligning student Individualized Educational Plans and assessments with these standards. Cooke School students participated in the MI-Access state assessment program in 2010-11. Although, Cooke School did not receive an Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) status under the federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act, Cooke students continue to make gains in the areas of English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science. The state does not issue report card grades for special education center programs. Each student at Cooke school has an individualized educational plan based on individual strengths and needs of the student. Cooke School meets with parents extensively at annual IEP meetings and provides quarterly progress reports throughout the school year.
